

THE TOWN OF JACKSON, WASHINGTON COUNTY, WISCONSIN
AMENDING ORDINANCE J-94-002 MANDATORY RECYCLING ORDINANCE

ORDINANCE NO. J-22-004

WHEREAS the Town of Jackson, Washington County established Ordinance J-94-002, a Mandatory Recycling Ordinance pursuant to Wis. Stat. Sec 66.035, on September 10, 1994; and

WHEREAS the Town is required to report the total quantity of all qualifying recyclables annually to The Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources (DNR); and

WHEREAS a portion of the Town of Jackson residences have entered into contracts to have recyclables collected by private haulers; and

WHEREAS the total quantity of recyclables collected by private haulers in the Town must also be reported annually to the Wisconsin DNR as if collected by the Town,

The Town Board of the Town of Jackson, Washington County, Wisconsin, do ordain, as follows:

1) Ordinance J-94-002 shall be amended as follows:

1.25 Private Waste/Recycling Haulers

A. **RESPONSIBILITIES OF WASTE HAULERS.** All waste haulers doing business in the Town shall file an annual report with the Town Clerk on or before February 1 which includes the tonnage of all qualifying recyclables, collected in the Town for the previous year.

This Ordinance shall become effective the day after proof of posting the same in three (3) public places in the Town and has been filed and recorded by the Town Clerk.


